

Alexandra Avenue Health and Social Care Centre



The entrance to the reception area is up the main steps or via disabled access to the front and back of the building. Please ring the bell for disabled access at the back, the lower ground floor automatic double doors will open outwards. Please report to reception when you arrive. There are disabled toilets in main waiting area. You can be booked with ambulance service if you need, just contact Reception before your appointment to arrange.

Opening Times: Monday to Friday; Late clinic run on a Thursday evening and one Saturday clinic a month

Accessibility:

Limited parking onsite but adjacent road side parking available

Easily accessed by pedestrians and disabled users from local stations and bus stops

Buses: 10 minute walk from Rayners Lane Station. **398** stops outside the Centre and runs every half an hour. **H12** runs from Pinner to South Harrow and stops at Rayners Lane and Eastcote Lane and it is a short walk to the Centre. **H10/H9** runs from Central Harrow.

Tube stations: South Harrow (Piccadilly Line), Rayners Lane (Piccadilly & Metropolitan Line)

Train Station: Northolt Park
